1. Welcome NEW ELAC officials

a. Ms. Jimenez welcomed the new officers: Dolores Gomez, Maria Dukes, Talpa Albanez, Marine Gazazyan (both Mrs. Albanez and Mrs. Gazayan are Secretaries).

2. ELAC Responsibilities

a. Ms. Jimenez reviewed the responsibilities of each officer's role (Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary) and also added that training will be offered at the start of the new SY.

3. New ELD Curriculum

a. Mrs. Cifuentes discussed the ELD class flow for all students MS and HS. She explained that MS will still be working with Edmentum while HS will have EDGE. In addition, both levels will have access to the new ELD curriculum from Language Tree: ELD 1 and ELD 2.

4. Reclassification
